Shoreline Community Women

Through continuous community support the club collected enough supplies for 249 boxes at an estimated value of \$110.00 or more per box. These boxes and messages of appreciation & support were shipped to troops stationed in Iraq & Afghanistan. Lists were circulated of needed items and notices were put in local paper. They collected cards and notes from children from different area schools, the local library, churches, and scout troops. They received monetary donations from local organizations and business. The boxes contain enough for soldiers to

share with each other and the local children. Shoreline Community Women plan to continue this project until the war is over. The monetary donation for the care packages was 4, 975.61 and non-monetary donations equaled 27, 500.
